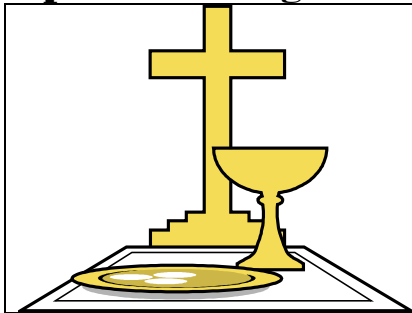
- Monday October 13 (Columbus Day)

Parent Meeting: October 22/ 7 PM

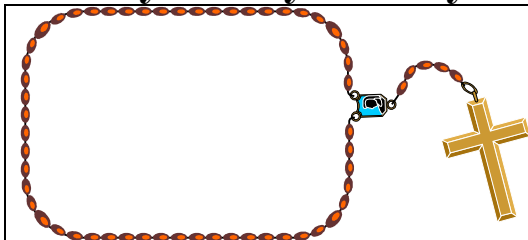
